# ANY ATTEMPT TO POISON CATS IS ILLEGAL

Section 531-403 of the Revised Code of the consolidated City-County entitled, "Attempts to poison animal," states, "*It shall be unlawful for a person to throw or deposit poisoned meat or any poison or harmful substance in any street, alley, marketplace or public place, or on any private premises, in the city for the purpose of destroying or injuring any animal.*" **Violators** of section 531-403 **may be fined up to \$2,500 FOR EACH VIOLATION** (per section 103-3.)

IndyFeral Inc. is offering a **REWARD** for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the POISONING OF CATS in this neighborhood.

To STOP THIS ILLEGAL ACT and apply for the reward, do the following now:

1. Immediately contact Indianapolis Animal Care and Control Division via the Mayor's Action Center at 317-327-4622. Give them the details of the situation and address where the crime is occurring and the name(s) of anyone committing the crime, if known.
2. Contact IndyFeral Inc. at 317-596-2300. Leave your name & phone number and the details of the situation, including the address where the crime is occurring, and the name(s) of anyone committing the crime, if known.
